

Stricter infection prevention measures for Stange in the weeks before Christmas

Developments around the coronavirus situation in the Stange region are cause for concern. The municipalities therefore feel the need to introduce stricter measures.

The first phase of the new restrictions ends on 23 December, but they may be extended if infection levels do not fall by then.

MEASURES IN STANGE UNTIL 23 DECEMBER:

Indoor culture, entertainment and leisure activities are prohibited

- Physical training centers etc
- Cinemas, theatres, concert venues, museums
- Bingo halls, bowling alleys, arcades, children's play facilities
- Activities for people with functional disabilities
- Activities for the elderly
- Swimming halls

Houses of faith and religious buildings have their own rules (see Indoor Events)

Libraries can remain open for borrowing and returning books etc.

Rehabilitation offered to individuals at training centers and the like can continue

Limitations on the number of customers in stores and at shopping centers

Stores must make certain customers can maintain a minimum distance of at least two meters from each other.

Indoor events are prohibited

The prohibition against indoor events has the following exceptions:

- Burials and funeral services can be conducted, but with max. 50 persons attending
- Church and prayer services can be conducted, but with max. 20 persons attending.
- Marriage ceremonies, baptisms and similar rituals can be conducted by those with a direct role in the ceremony and without guests attending.
- Events for the disadvantaged, under the auspices of organizations and municipal operators, can be conducted with max. 20 persons attending.
- Elite-level sports events are permitted, without spectators.

Outdoor events

Outdoor events are permitted with max. 100 persons attending. Everyone who is not in the same household must remain at least one meter away from each other.

Private gatherings of more than 10 persons are not permitted, or where the distance of at least one meter cannot be maintained

- The number of households that gather should be limited

- The premises must be large enough for all participants to maintain a minimum distance of at least one meter from each other.

Public transit

- Please show special consideration for your fellow passengers
- Face masks are recommended when it is not possible to maintain a safe distance from others of 1 meter.

Face masks in taxis

- Passengers shall use a face mask in taxis.
- Drivers must wear face masks when there are passengers in the taxi.

Restrictions for food and beverage outlets

Food and beverage outlets such as bars and restaurants must close at 22:00.

As before, the rules for visiting nursing homes are already strict:

- All visits must be pre-arranged.
- Persons newly arrived from abroad for Christmas vacation should not visit nursing homes
